- (a) The completed application must be delivered to the Bury Cemetery Office, St. Peter's Road, Bury (telephone 0161 253 6510 / tel/fax 016 762 9506) **at least two weeks before permit is required.**
- (b) All Masons must comply with the Council's Cemetery Regulations as made from time to time. Copies of the Cemetery Regulations may be obtained from the Registrar at the Cemetery Office.
- (c) All memorials must be erected in accordance with the Code of Practice of the National association of Memorial Masons. New monuments must be positioned in line with existing monuments in the cemetery
- (d) The permit must be handed in at the Cemetery Office prior to erection.
- (e) The applicant must comply with the cemetery regulations as made from time to time, including restrictions in connection with gardening of graves.
